

TWO YEARS OF ONGOING MINISTRY: \$6.5 MILLION

Thanks to your generosity, our ongoing ministries are fully funded for 2025 — praise God! Your support sustains Elmhurst CRC's vital work spanning all ages and stages, from weekday ministries through weekend worship, covering our campus and spreading out to the world.



DEBT ELIMINATION: \$4 MILLION

We've cut our debt by more than half —
from over \$4 million in 2024 to under
\$2 million — freeing significant resources.
These savings now strengthen our
ministries, support future growth, and build
a more secure financial foundation.

MINISTRY EXPANSION: \$1 MILLION

We have the opportunity to continue funding bold new steps as we grow UP, IN, and OUT.



- Hired a full-time Director of Engagement Jason Turner to foster community, small group engagement, and discipleship through congregational ministries
- Doubled our youth ministry programming and staff Luke Norris & Emily Simonis — to actively invest in the next generation
- Expanded our Missions budget, deepening partnerships locally with Lawndale (Chicago) and globally with Nurmay Missions (Kenya)
- Hosted the weekly Elmhurst Farmers Market from May-October, welcoming over 25,000 visitors while deepening our community connections and outreach

IN PROGRESS

- Designating a portion of our building to create an accessible space focused on the ministry of prayer
- Setting aside additional funds for anticipated capital maintenance projects so that our congregational giving can focus on ministry and outreach directly
